At Key Stage 4 this builds on the work at Key Stage 3. It will

1. Help you to become more confident.
2. Help you to identify your priorities, strengths, weaknesses and attitudes and set targets for improvement.
3. Help you to understand and take in to account the main influences affecting your learning and career choices.
4. Help you to explore and understand the range of choices open to you post 16, by using a wide range of resources, information, advice and guidance.
5. Help you to be aware of the way the world of work is changing and the impact that has on the decisions you may make.
6. Help you to be able to explain the reasons for your chosen post 16 route.
7. Help you to be more aware of what employers are looking for in relation to work.
8. Help you to make effective and successful applications for learning and work, including CVs, written applications and interviews.
